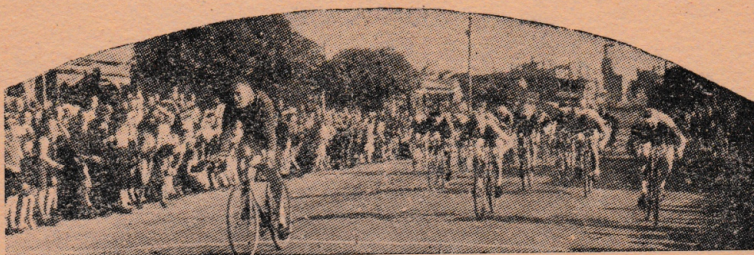

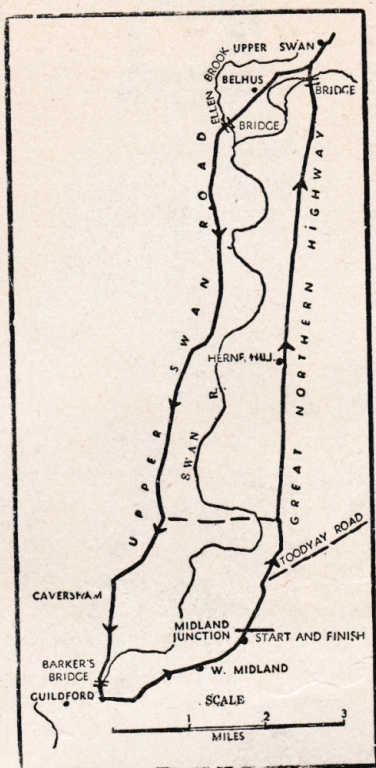

Important Notice

FRIENDS of competitors following the race are requested to note that one of the rules of the race reads that a car must not be nearer than 200 yards to a rider. Stewards will report to the referee any rider who receives encouragement from a car nearer than this distance, and it is in the referee's power to disqualify that rider immediately. Don't jeopardise the chances of a rider—KEEP WELL OUT of the WAY, and there will then be no arguments.

Competitors and enthusiasts should also note that riders may not receive any outside assistance in any shape or form. Riders must carry their own Drinks and Food, and may replenish only at the Official Feed Stations. Notices reading "Official Feed Station" will be displayed.

INSTRUCTIONS TO RIDERS

Riders will muster in Spring Park Road and be ready for Grand Parade at 10 a.m. prior to the start which is scheduled for 10.30 a.m.

Starting point to be in Great Northern Highway opposite the Ascension Park proceeding to a first turning 1 mile beyond Upper Swan Bridge. Returning through the West Swan, Caversham District over Meadow Street Bridge. Turning East at Guildford Police Station, to starting point.

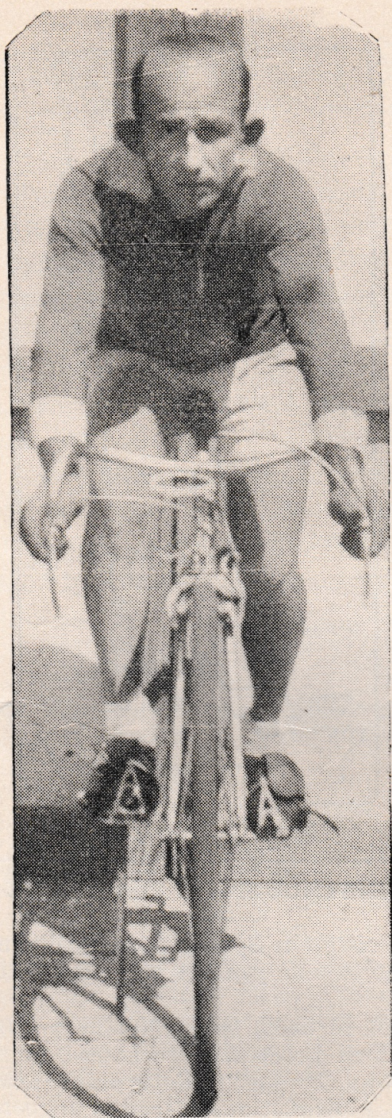
Remaining four laps direct through West Swan and Caversham district.

ANY RIDER WHO IS A LAP BEHIND AND BEING OVERTAKEN SHALL NOT SHELTER OR PACE THE OVERTAKING RIDER.

PENALTY: DISQUALIFICATION OF BOTH RIDERS.

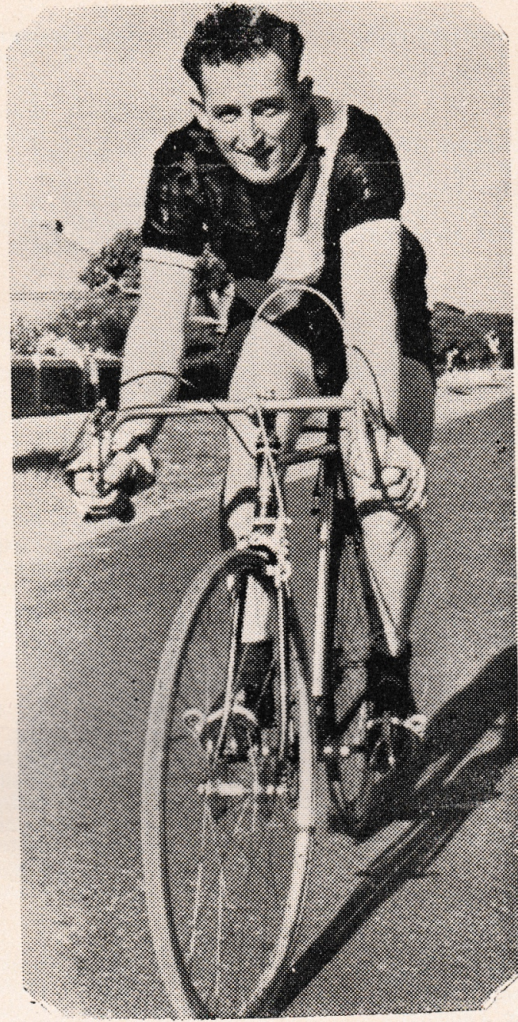
Riders must claim placings by contacting Mr. Kosterich at Finishing Line.

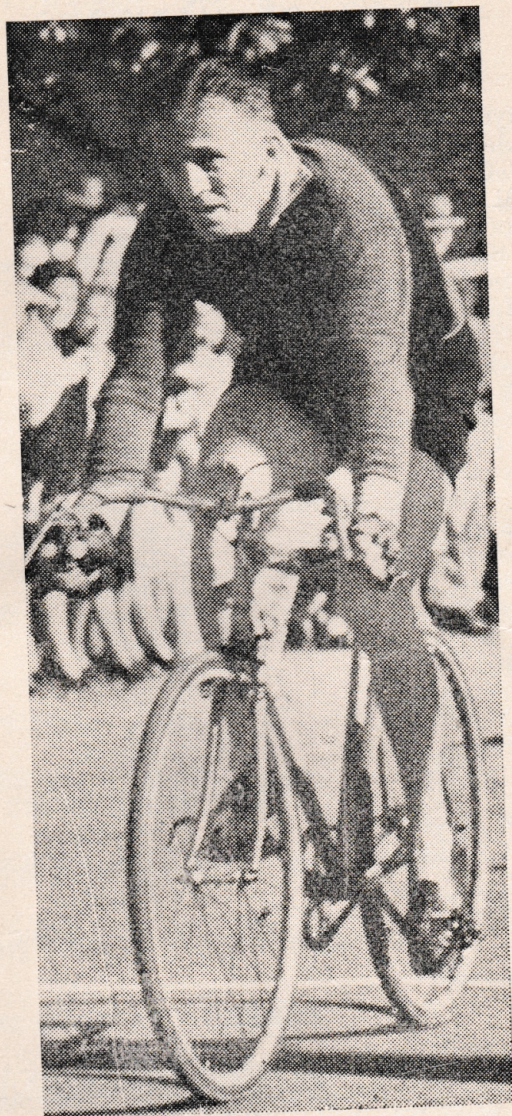
