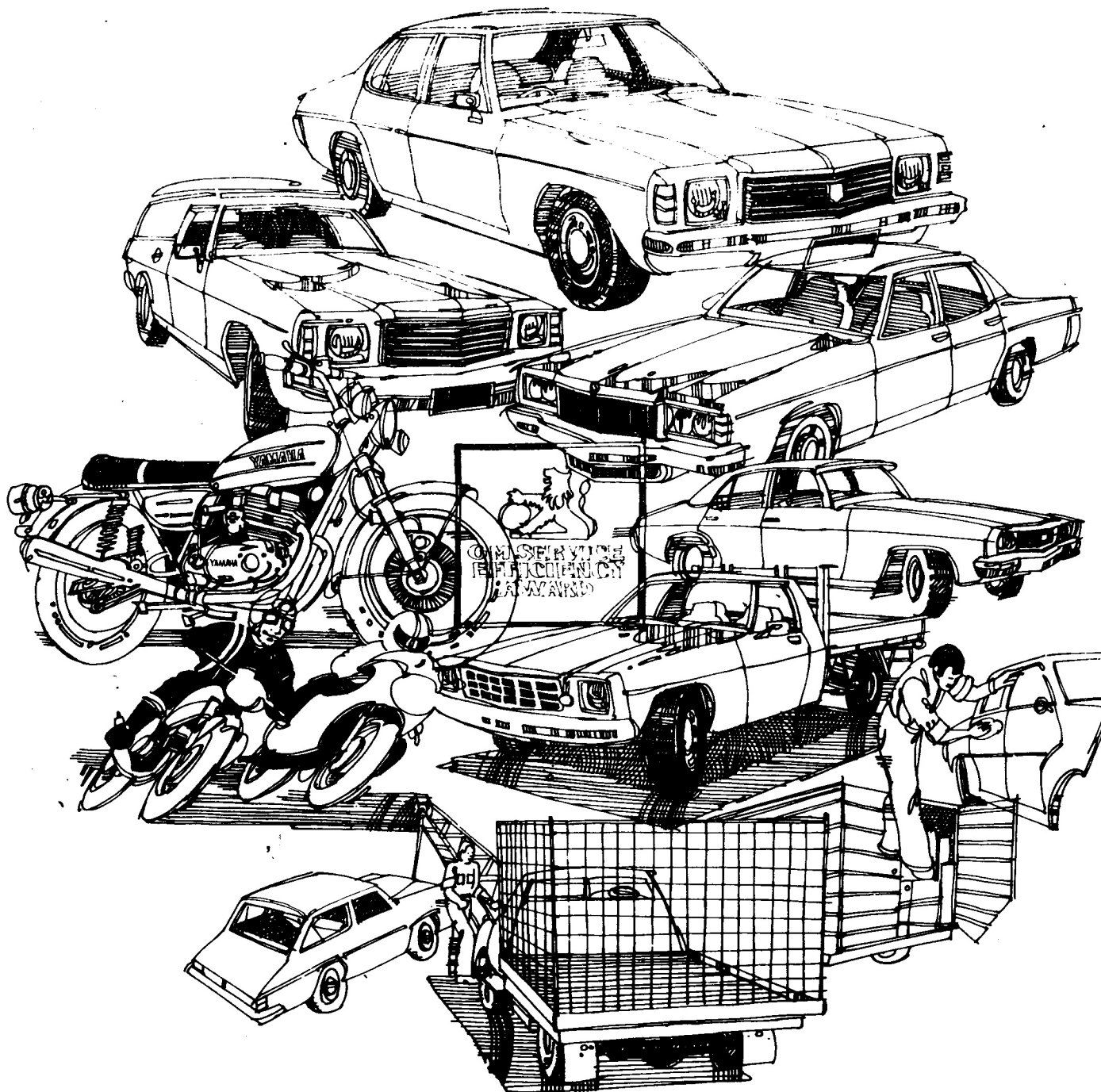

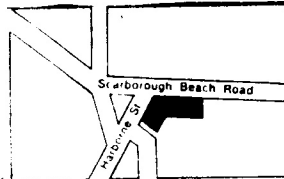
THE COURSE.

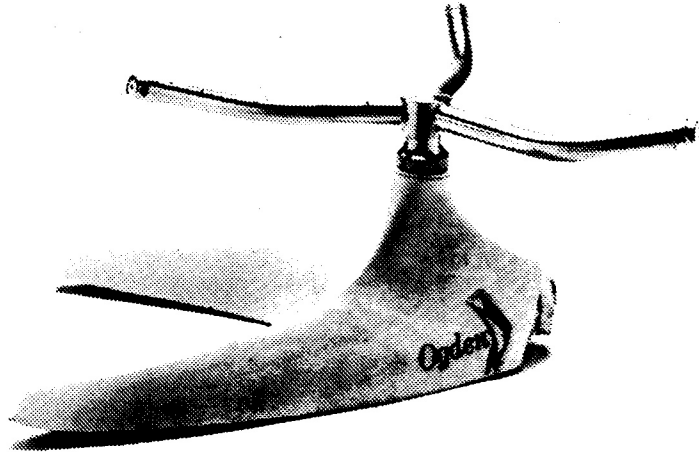

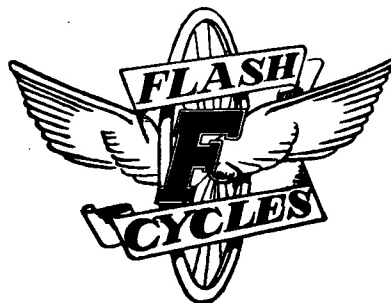

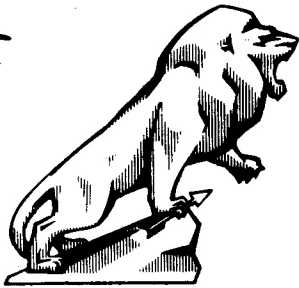
